**Notice to Skanska's Contractual Partners: Parent Company of Oy Teboil Ab, Lukoil OAO, added to Sanctions List**

Skanska is committed to conducting sustainable business. It is also our duty to ensure that sustainable practices are followed throughout our supply chain.

As part of our sustainability efforts, we comply with international sanctions regulations. Our sanctions monitoring checks the known ultimate beneficial owners of companies, including their parent companies and owners, and we regularly monitor any changes in this information.

Lukoil OAO was added to the UK sanctions list on 15th October 2025 (The Russia (Sanctions) (EU Exit) Regulations 2019), and on 22th October 2025 the United States has set Lukoil to OFAC Specially Designated Nationals list. Our sanctions policy also includes compliance with sanctions imposed by the United Kingdom and the United States.

Oy Teboil Ab is wholly owned by Lukoil OAO.

We ask our contractual partners to take into account the sanctions clause in our contract terms, according to which Skanska's contractual partner represents, assures and is responsible for not using construction products or subcontractors that are subject to the sanctions or restrictions mentioned in the contract terms. This should be taken into account for example in relation to the use of fuel in machinery, transport, and production. Compliance with the sanctions policy applies to all current and new contracts.
